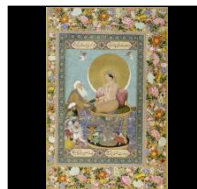

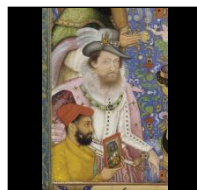

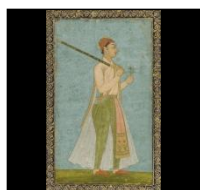

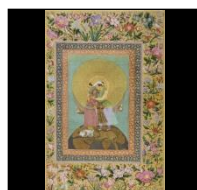
Detail of James I of England

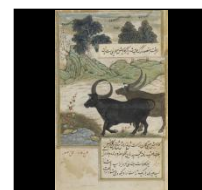
Parinirvana

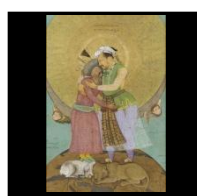

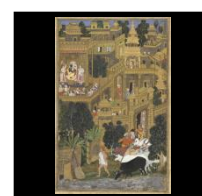

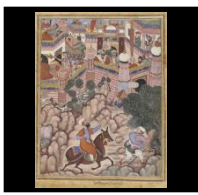

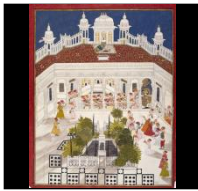

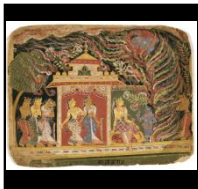

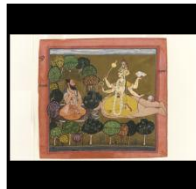

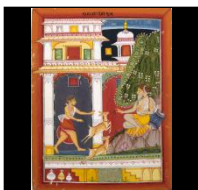

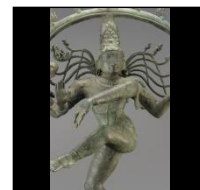

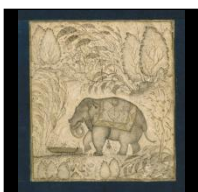
